Introduction

The fifth Component 3 Status Report presents activities of the Component 3 in the six months from 17 November 2016 to 16 May 2017.

Activities within Component 3 during the fifth period of implementation included mainly analyses of three topics agreed in Action plan for 2017 for Component 3, organisation of events for exchanging the opinions and best practices, preparing the documents and reports foreseen for 2017, as well as finishing the activities planned for 2016.

The topics analysed in the reviewed period have been as following:

- 3.2.2 Optimization of social assistance procedures and eligibility criteria for social assistance benefits
- 3.2.3 Coordination of overall social assistance resources
- 3.2.4 Fraud in social assistance: identification, coping strategy and prevention

The main priority was to complete the second result of the C3 Project (R10: The legal frameworks on a) formulation of unified standards for the estimation and calculation of social assistance benefits, b) recognition of social assistance target groups c) identification of low-income families are consolidated").

In the reviewed period C3 has been focusing on the extended exchange of EU practices and recommendations on the occasion of the 2^{nd} C3 Workshop supported by 3 EU senior experts.

The 2nd C3 Workshop was hosted by MoCA on December 13th, 2016. The main issues presented and discussed were dedicated to the three research topics and focused on governance in social assistance, policy transmission and implementation between and by different institutional and social assistance level.

Component 3 was working on 2017 planning together will Component 3 stakeholders mainly MoCA and Consortium Member Countries. C3 was also preparing the oversaes activities for the second half of the year: training and study visits.

In the reviewed period C3 coordinated and published all 2016 research outputs in the three Volumes separately in English and Chinese. The implementation of the Component 3 2017 work plan has been initiated by starting the research on assessment reports within three selected topics performed by Chinese experts.

The visibility of the Project has been improved thanks to better functioning of the project website and creating a special column on MoCA's official website dedicated to C3. Component 3 has prepared bilingual newsletter during the period under review.

The period under review was therefore also characterized by the continued excellent collaboration between MoCA, the C3 based project team and Polish Ministry of Family, Labour and Social Policy.

1.1 Background information on the Component activities and results

This report describes implementation of activities under the Component 3 – support MoCA on improving of legal framework and policy for social assistance - of the EU-China Social Protection Reform Project. It covers the period from 17 November 2016 to 16 May 2017.

1.1.1 Results pursued

Within Component 3 of the project there are 3 of 11 identified results - results R9 to R11 inclusive, namely:

- Promulgating and enforcing the Social Assistance Law and the regulations on rural and urban minimum standards of living;
- Developing of legal framework on unified standards for defining social assistance benefits, target groups, low income families; and,
- Improving care for poor rural people and disabled people as well public information and transparency on social assistance policy.

MoCA is the main stakeholder and beneficiary for Component 3 activities.

Topics being explored in 2017 contribute mainly to the R10 – topics 3.2.2; 3.2.3; 3.2.4. (R10 - "Result 10: The legal frameworks on a) formulation of unified standards for the estimation and calculation of social assistance benefits, b) recognition of social assistance target groups c) identification of low-income families are consolidated").

For 2017 there are foreseen 3 topics to complet research in. These support mailny Result 10 of the Project.

1.1.2 Analysed topics

The PAC meeting held on 22 February 2017 agreed on the topics to be considered within Component 3 activities. See Annex X. Some adjustment has been made to take into account the priorities of MoCA since the elaboration of the Grant application form.

In 2017 under Component 3 three topics will be elaborated. See table 1. Component 3 is performing research activities related mainly to the topics 3.2.2; 3.2.3; and 3.2.4. All topics are a subject of an evaluation in a view of continued relevance and to the constant monitoring of the evolving socioeconomic situation, as well as Government priorities in terms of social assistance system.

As agreed, the topics 3.2.2, 3.2.3, 3.2.4 are being under research activities from January/February 2017 by three Chinese experts.

All finalised reports are published in a C3 2017 volume for each of the three topics and shared with a broader audience via the Project website.

1.1.3 Best practices

Component 3 identification of the most relevant best practices (related to topics 3.2.1 and 3.3.1) from the EU for China was provided in strong cooperation and consultation with MoCA.

For the 2nd C3 Workshop on the topics 3.1.2, 3.1.3, 3.1.4 Component 3 was able to select and ensure mission for three EU experts: Mr. Andreas Tesas; Ms. Josee Goris and Mr. Jean-Yves Hosquet. All

experts contributed actively to the workshop hosted by MoCA on December 13th, 2016 and provided solid base of the knowledge on the best practices report for each of the topic as well relevant policy recomendations.

Those are available and published in a C3 2017 volume (bilingual version) and shared with a broader audience via the Project website.

In June next wave of EU experertise sharing will be organised and support the 4th C3 Panel Discussion hosted by MoCA. Based on the assessments of Chinese social assistance in the field of 2017 topics as well discussion and exchanges between Chinese and EU best practises a report for the three topics: 3.2.2; 3.2.3 and 3.2.4 will be provided.

The implementation of the project proved that in order to increase the relevance and to improve the focus of exposure to European best practices under each of the related topics, the selection of European best practices should respond to the needs identified by the Chinese counterparts.

1.1.4 Stakeholders

The main Chinese stakeholder for Component 3 of the Project is the Ministry of Civil Affairs (MoCA). Department of Social Assistance in MoCA is the lead technical unit for Component 3.

Annex XI to this report lists national stakeholders – target audience and beneficiaries – for C3 activities, as described in the report "Audience for Project results".

The list could be updated in line with pilot sites which will be identified on a later stage according to the MoCA indication.

1.1.5 Overseas activities

Component 3 work plan for 2017 has included three to four EU activities (training and study visits) for MoCA delegation to several EU countries (including non Consortium countries). One of them under the leadership of Deputy Minister MoCA Mr Gong Pugang and the other one for technical purpose.

1.1.6 Human resources

The contract of the EU resident expert for Component 3, Ms Marzena Breza took effect on 23 December 2014. The EU resident expert of Component 3, within the Beijing Office in the assessed period was assisted by Ms Caihua Zhong till February/March 2017 and currently by Ms Miao Yijun. Component 3 is lacking operational Chinese expert mainly due to budget limitations and availability of Chinese experts in social assistance. This makes the daily cooperation with Chinese beneficiary (MoCA) much more challenging also from the perspective of limited efficiency of English communation between the Resident Expert and MoCA.

During the period under review three Chinese experts were allocated for Component 3. Around 120 working days (under new budget arrangements) will be allocated among CN experts in 2017. For the EU experts around 50 working days are foreseen to be allocated in 2017.

1.1.7 Visibility

C3RE supports the team from the horizontal Secretairait with all related background information and papers performed under C3 activities for the purpose of publishing on the Project webpage on a regular basis.

C3 (in line with C1) has published Component Newsletters. All can be reached from the new Project website http://www.euchinasprp.eu/index.php/en/ as well.

Additionally, to improve the visibility of Component 3 EU-China SPRP, a special column on MoCA's official website information about the activities on Component 3 was created.

1.2 Activities

The current chapter presents a summary of activities conducted during the period under Component 3.

It follows the structure of the Plan of activities for 2016 adopted by the PAC meeting on 6 April 2016 and for 2017 work plan by the PAC held on 22 February 2017.

1.2.1 Situational analysis

The 2016 Activity plan for C3 endorsed by the PAC meeting on 6 April states that "under Component 3 three topics will be a subject of situational analysis in 2016, namely: 3.1.2, 3.1.3, 3.1.4."

Situation analysis for the three topics has been conducted by three Chinese experts selected jointly by MoCA and the C3 resident expert and shared with the C3 Component Coordinator.

All topics will be a subject of an evaluation in a view of continued relevance, and to the constant monitoring of the evolving socio-economic situation, as well as Government priorities in terms of social assistance system.

Due to the priority treatment of the topics 3.1.1, 3.2.1, 3.3.1, that were still reviewed in 2016, the evaluation of topics 3.2.2, 3.2.3, 3.2.4 started in January/February as shown in table 5 below.

The main priority is to complete the first result (R9 - The capacity of the MoCA for promulgating and enforcing the Social Assistance Law and the regulations on rural and urban minimum standards of living are strengthened; the skills of local officials in policy transmission and implementation are upgraded).

While the official requirement of the Project is to prepare reports in English, all authors agreed that the impact of their work would be more immediate if a Chinese version was also available for the direct use of national stakeholders. In case of Component 3 main steps to ensure the CN and EN reports are undertaken by MoCA with some support of EU-China SPRP Office.

Following the experience of 2015&2016, the project in 2017 implemented in close cooperation with MoCA, which is the main national stakeholder for Component 3-3 topics, see Table 6

Coherence among the various situational analysis will be provided by mid-term peer review and quality control conducted by Chinese short-term experts working under the supervision of the C3 EU Resident expert and MoCA.

It is envisaged that a European expert will be provided for the situational analysis for each topic in order to ascertain that the assessment reports correspond to the level and quality of information required allowing for proper matching with the corresponding EU experience in terms of best practices.

The output of this activity is to provide an adequate knowledge of Chinese situation related to the topic under consideration. The assessment reports in English document the findings and conclusions of the Chinese experts.

1.2.2 Identification and Review of possible European experience

For 2016 in Component 3 there was one EU mission for three EU experts organised. All of them supported the 2nd C3 Workshop (December 2017). The next mission of EU experts to Beijing is planned for June/July 2017.

An extended opportunity for exchange EU practises will be performed within 2 weeks training which is planned for June 2017.

1.2.3 Cross-topic activities

1.2.3.1 Panel discussions

The 4th Panel discussion under the 2017 work plan is foreseen for June 2017 namely for topics 3.2.2; 3.2.3; 3.2.4.

1.2.3.2 Workshops on the analysis phase

The C3 activity plan for 2016 as adopted by the PAC meeting on 6 April 2016 foresees a workshop aiming at reviewing the topics analyzed in 2016.

The 2nd C3 Workshop has been organised by MoCA on December 13th, 2016.

For this workshop three short-term EU experts - one for each topic namely 3.1.2; 3.1.3 and 3.1.4 was presenting best practises and policy recommendations.

1.2.3.3 Component management

During the period under review the team of C3 in Beijing consisted of C3 Resident Expert and part-time Component Assistant as from February 2016. As from 1st January 2016 C3 team is supported by a new Secretariat – Expertise France.Beside that cooperation with MoCA counterparts is functioning on a daily basis - regular joint meetings are held to review all pending, outstanding or proposed questions mainly coordinated by the C3RE.

1.2.4 Pilot Sites/Local Visits

MoCA has not selected the pilot sites in 2017. However, the comprehensive framework of the pilots has been dicussed. A reseach will take place in the next months to support local staff with the topics and instruments to be used when introducing EU examples.

For this specific task senior Chinese expert will be selected to review policy proposals made by EU and Chinese experts (including motivation) and next propose a program for the pilots to be undertaken in 2017-2018 in a few provinces in China.

The next C3 Panel Discussion follows by a seminar session scheduled for June 2017 aims at focusing the discussion on target, measures and scope of the pilots for the 2017-2018. A foundation for the discussion will be the previous research executed by Prof. Guan Xinping and Mr Mihai Magheru.

1.2.4.1 Research study: Follow up of 2015 EU-China High Level Forum on Social Protection Reform Challenges for Legal Framework of Social Assistance

The HLF 2015 has given an excellent opportunity for a high level dialog between the EU and China. In addition Component 3 undetook two types of reseach. One of them relates to study on social assistance structures of P.R. China - main achievements of and challenges and the other focuces on most relevant EU countries experiences for social assistance structures of China. Both studies had been completed. Finally an event sumping up all the ouputs from both research will be dicussed possibly within a seminar session (back to back 4th C3 Panel Discussion) with experts and policy makers participation.

1.2.5 Planning for the next period

Over the next 6 months of the Project (17 May 2017 – 16 November 2017) the programme of activities for 2017 will be advanced, and planning 2018 will start as well.

1.2.6 2017 Activities

Continuing activities from 2016 and performing plan of activities for Component 3 approved by the PAC meeting on 6 April, following actions have been already successfully performed:

The 3-topics 2nd C3 Workshop hosted by MoCA on December 13th, 2016. The event was supported by 3 EU short-term experts Annex XIV showsthe revised work plan for C3 proposed activities, covering the period until February 2018.

The following paragraphs briefly address the following issues:

- Completing 2016 programme;
- Choosing technical topics for 2017;
- Conducting overseas activities;
- Visibility.

1.2.6.1 Choosing technical topics for 2017

During preliminary consultations with MoCA it was proposed to focus on three topics as included in the table 9. The topics choosen have been renamed according to the original ones included in Grant

application form. The current topics are in line with the actual needs of MoCA and the tasks to be undertaken in 2017.

Coherence among the various situational analysis will be provided by mid-term peer review and quality control conducted by Chinese short-term experts working under the supervision of the C3 EU Resident expert and MoCA.

Based on the experience from the year 2016, panel discussion and workshop will be organised to disucss the preliminary findings of the Chinese research as well as to exchange EU expertise.

These Panel discussions would gather the Chinese experts dealing with the respective situational analysis, representatives of the interested Chinese stakeholders and the Component management. Consideration will be given to the possibility of arranging videoconference for the event, to facilitate participation by interested EU Member states specialists.

To support the Panel discussions sessions and in the production of subsequent panel reports – the preliminary set of reform proposals to follow with the corresponding requirement to deepen knowledge on most relevant European best practices will be prepared – ad hoc support will be provided by 1 Chinese and 1 European expert.

Panel discussions

Panel discussion for three interrelated topics has been tentatively scheduled for June 2017.

This Panel discussion would gather the Chinese experts in charge of the respective situational analysis, representatives of the interested Chinese stakeholders and the Component management.

To support the Panel discussion sessions and the production of subsequent panel reports, the preliminary set of reform proposals to follow with the corresponding requirement to deepen knowledge on most relevant European best practices will be prepared. Ad hoc support will be provided by 3 Chinese and 3 European experts - one for each of the three reports.



The output of this activity will be a solid ground for a preliminary formulation of desirable areas for reforms under the concerned topics, and a selection of European best practices worth deepening for that purpose. Deliverables will be reports on the Panel discussion sessions prepared by Chinese and European experts.

Workshop on the Analysis Phase

This activity represents a logical continuation of the Panel discussion sessions. The workshop will represent a unique opportunity, after duly analyzing the Chinese situation and the most relevant EU best practices, to start considering a set of draft reform proposals concerning the variety of topics already introduced under Component 3 Plan of activities, 2017.

The 3rd Component 3 Workshop has been tentatively scheduled for November/December 2017.

The Workshop will gather high level representatives of the Chinese stakeholders, Chinese and European experts and Component 3 representatives. Provisions could be made to facilitate attendance via videoconference of interested consortium members and project leadership. However due to the time constrains it can be a challenging issue.

The preparation, holding and subsequent reporting of the workshop would benefit from the support of 1 Chinese and 1 EU expert for each of the three topics recruited for the project. The results and conclusions of the Workshop would be of direct use in shaping reform proposals and designing related technical assistance activities, including development of ad hoc tools, as foreseen under the Grant application form Follow Up phase (Macro-activities 3.8 and ff.).

Output of the Workshop will be a solid ground for considering further possible reform options to be finalised, and designing a programme of accompanying technical assistance and technical tools development to be implemented under project auspices. The deliverables will be the Workshop report including proposals for reform options on each of the three topics being a subject of situational analysis in 2017, and a first set of proposed activities for a technical assistance programme and the development of relevant technical tools under the framework of the project Component 3.

Follow up of the 2015 EU-China High Level Forum on Social Protection Reform Challenges for Legal Framework of Social Assistance

The research study outputs executed by Chinese and UE experts will be discussed during a seminar session which is planned to be organized jointly with 4th Panel Discussion meeting in June 2017.

1.2.6.2 Conducting overseas activities

For 2017, three to four European activities¹ are foreseen for Component 3.

The first EU event organized in close cooperation between MoCA, Component 3 SPRP and INPS is a ministerial visit to Italy in May 2017. The main goal of the visit is to strengthen cooperation between MoCA and Italian authorites dealing with social assistance on the basis of the current EU-China SPRP Project (Componen 3) and its possible follow up.

In June 2017, under the leadership of MoCA, a training in France has been planned. The training venues will be Paris and Strasbourg.




