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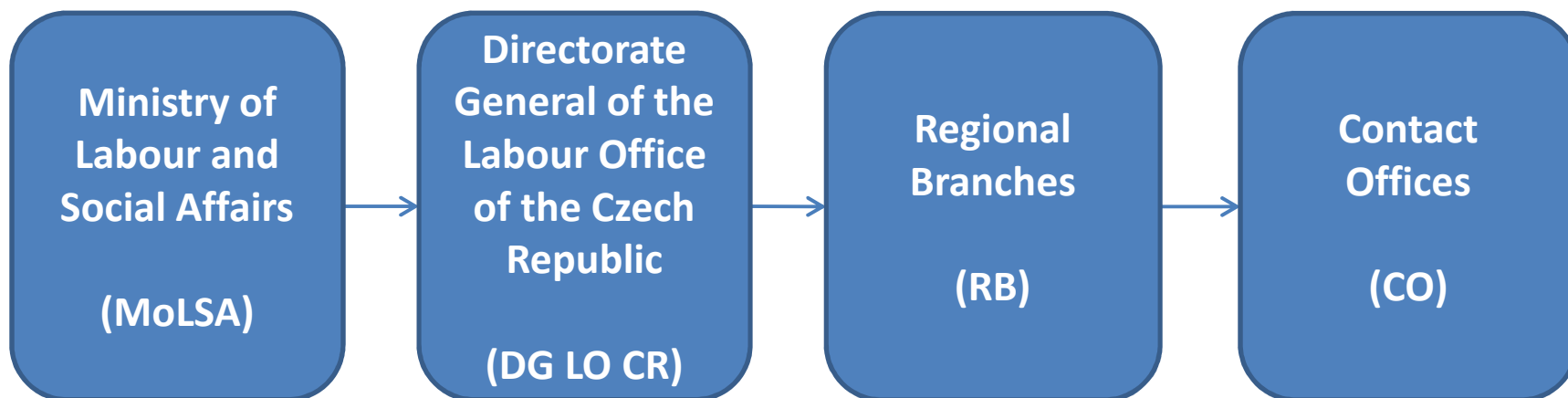

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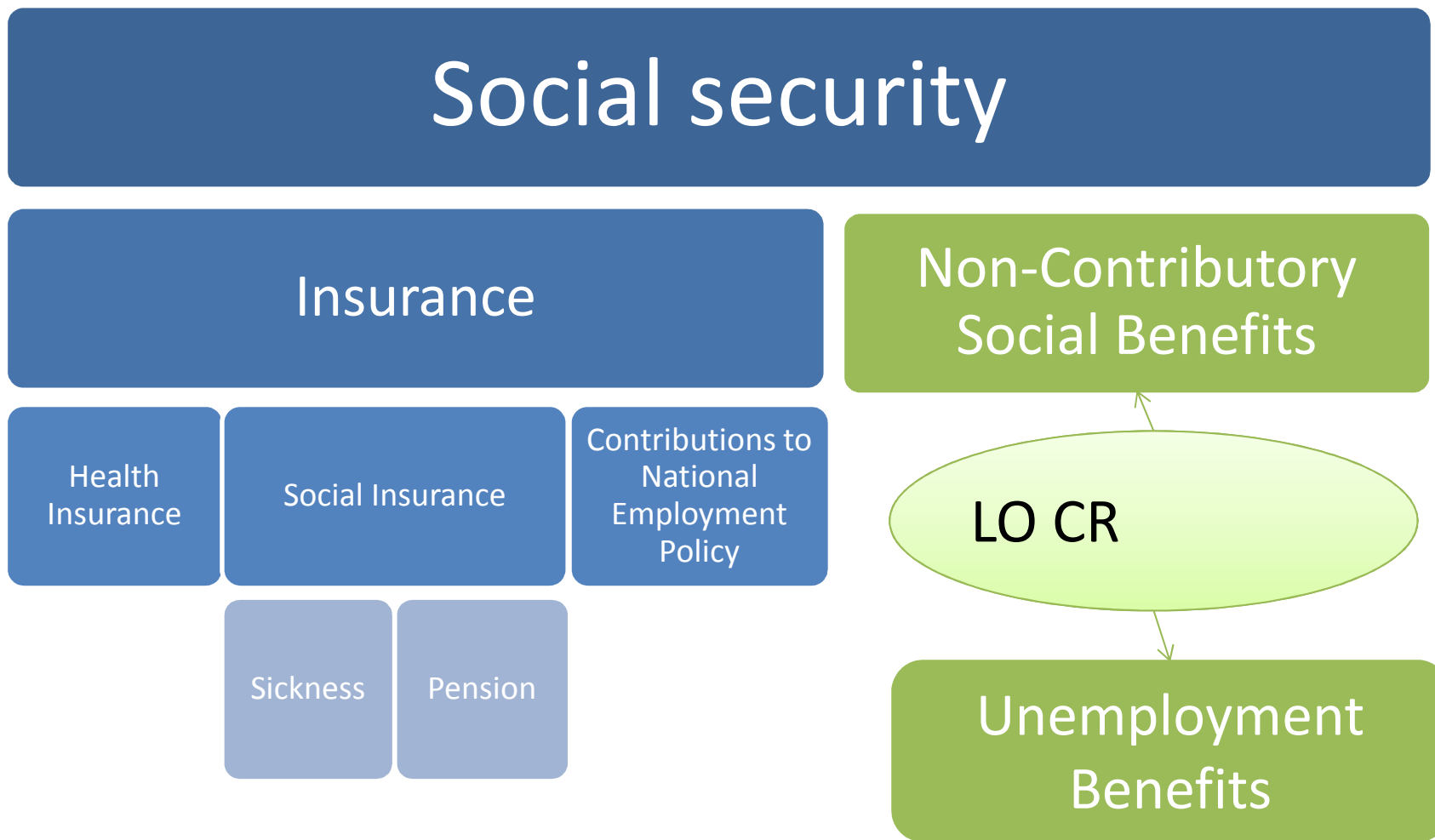

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3. Organizational structure of the LO CR 14 Regional Branches

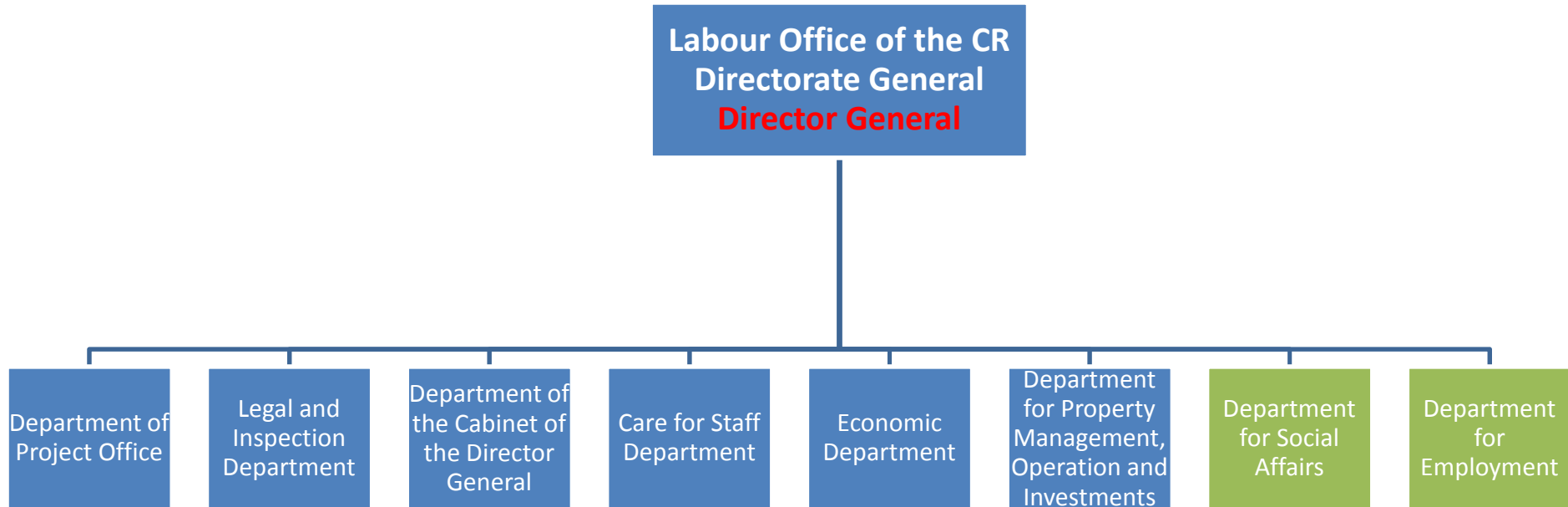

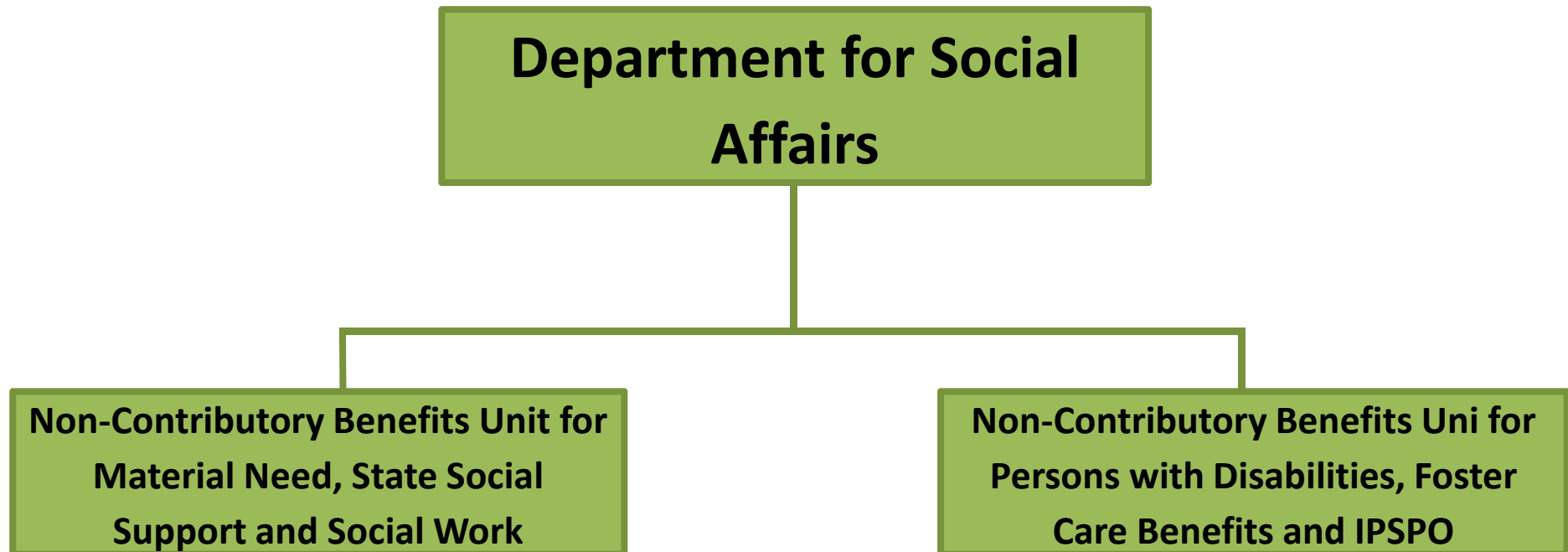
Organizational structure of the Directorate General of the LO CR

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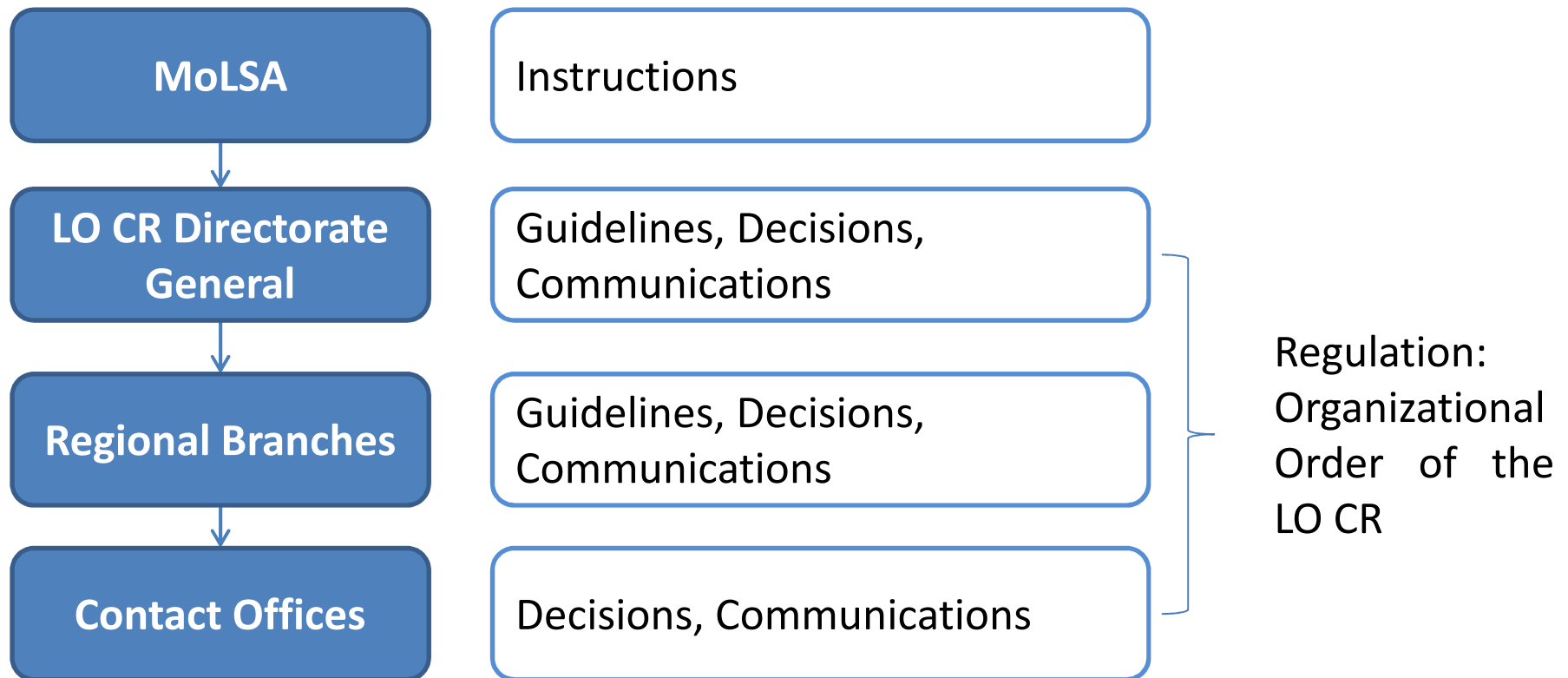

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5. Database in the area of social benefits 5/3

Data harmonisation:

- Within LO CR (Unemployment benefits and State Social Support benefits),
- Financial Administration,
- Czech Social Security Administration (Pension insurance benefits and sickness insurance benefits),
- Ministry of Interior – ISEO (Inhabitants' Registry Information System), CIS (Foreigner Information System).



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6. Non-contributory social benefits

6/1

- LO CR in charge of all such benefits since 1st Jan 2012
- MoLSA is the appellate body
- The benefits help to combat social exclusion
- The aim is to reasonably narrow the differences between social situation of individual as well as families
- Criterion of adequacy of elimination narrowing the differences is the **safeguarding of minimum living conditions.**



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6. Non-contributory social benefits

Amounts of Subsistence Minimum and Existence Minimum

Subsistence Minimum (CZK/month, since 1st Jan 2012)	
Single individual	3 410
First person in the household	3 140
Second and every other person in the household who is not a dependent child	2 830
Child under 6 years of age	1 740
Child between 6 and 15 years of age	2 140
Child from 15 to 26 years of age	2 450
Existence Minimum (CZK/month, since 1st Jan 2012)	2 200



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6. Amounts of the subsistence and existence minimum

Subsistence minimum (€ per month)	
Individual	126
The first person in the household	126
The second and other person in the household (not dependent child)	105
Child up to 6 years of age	64
Child from 6 to 15 years	79
Child from 15 to 26 years	90
Existence minimum (€ per month)	81



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6. Setting of the thresholds for benefits entitlement 6/3

Entitlement based on Subsistence Minimum:

- Entitlement to Child Allowance has a dependent child living in a family with decisive income lower than 2.7fold of that family's Subsistence Minimum amount.
- Entitlement to Birth Grant is based on income of the family in the calendary quarter preceding the birth of the child – it must be below 2.7fold of the Subsistence Minimum amount.

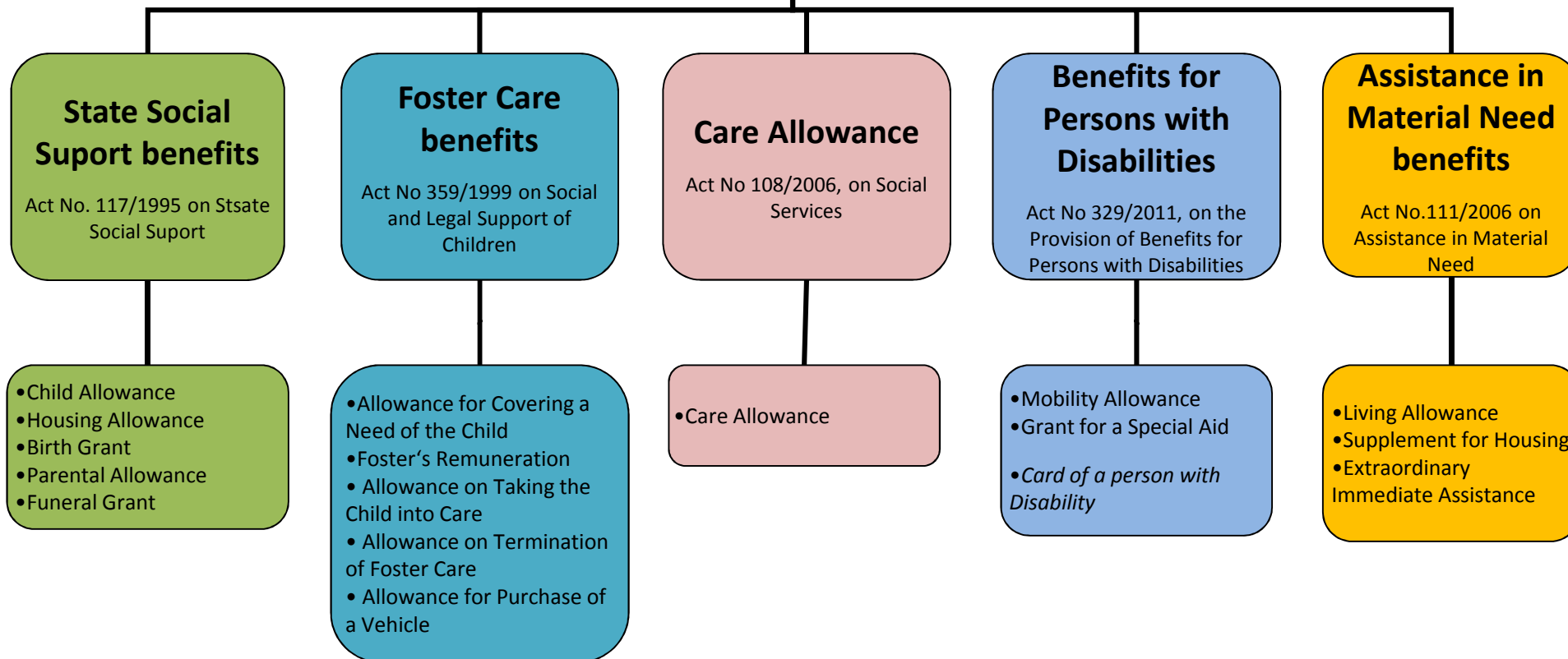

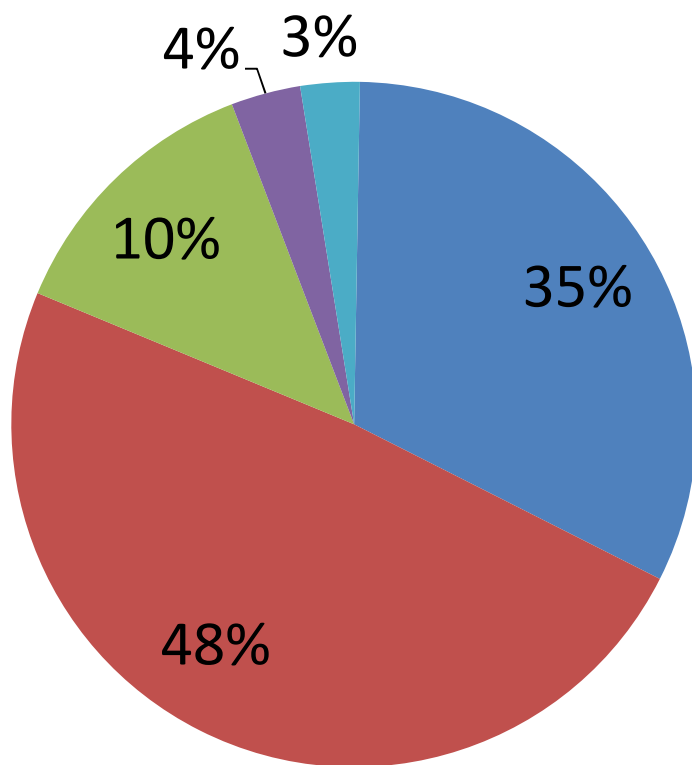

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State Social Support benefits

Child Allowance

For low-income families, CZK 500, 610, 700/month depending on the age of the child (+ possible increase by CZK 300 based on the income)

Housing Allowance

Housing costs are over 30 % of total income of the family, monthly

Birth Grant

First child – CZK 13.000
Second child – CZK 10.000

Parental Allowance *

CZK 220.000 (330.000 if twins, paid monthly until 4 years of age of the child)

Funeral Grant *

One off CZK 5.000 for dependent child or parent of such child

* Benefits granted regardless the applicant's income



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Foster Care benefits

**Allowance for
Covering the Child's
Need**

Amount depends on the age and health status of the dependent child (CZK 4.950 – 9.900 per month). May be paid up to 26 years of age.

**Foster's
Remuneration**

Amount depends on the type of care, number and health status of the children (CZK 12.000 – 30.000 per month – gross income), for each additional child the amount may be increased by CZK 6.000/month in certain cases.

**Allowance on Taking a
Child into Care**

According to the age of the child (0-6, 6-12, 12-18 years) CZK 8.000, 9.000 or 10.000

**Allowance on Termination
of Foster Care**

CZK 25.000 per person who was in foster care on the day of reaching maturity

**Allowance for Purchase of
a Vehicle**

3 or more children in foster care, 70 pct. of the price, limit is CZK 100.000



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Care Allowance

Care Allowance

Granted to persons **dependent on care of other natural person**. Through the allowance, the state contributes to safeguarding social services or other form of assistance to managing basic living needs

There are 4 dependency levels used for setting the benefit amount

Age/dependency level	Level I	Level II	Level III	Level IV
Under 18 years	CZK 3 300*	CZK 6 600*	CZK 9 900*	CZK 13 200*
Over 18 years	CZK 880*	CZK 4 400*	CZK 8 800*	CZK 13 200*

* In specific cases, it is possible to increase the allowance by CZK 2.000 (low-income families).



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Benefits for Persons with Disabilities

- Cash benefits aimed at alleviating social impact of disability and to support social inclusion of the persons with disabilities.

Mobility Allowance

CZK 550 per month – to cover transportation costs

Grant for Special Aid

Up to CZK 850.000 in 5 years



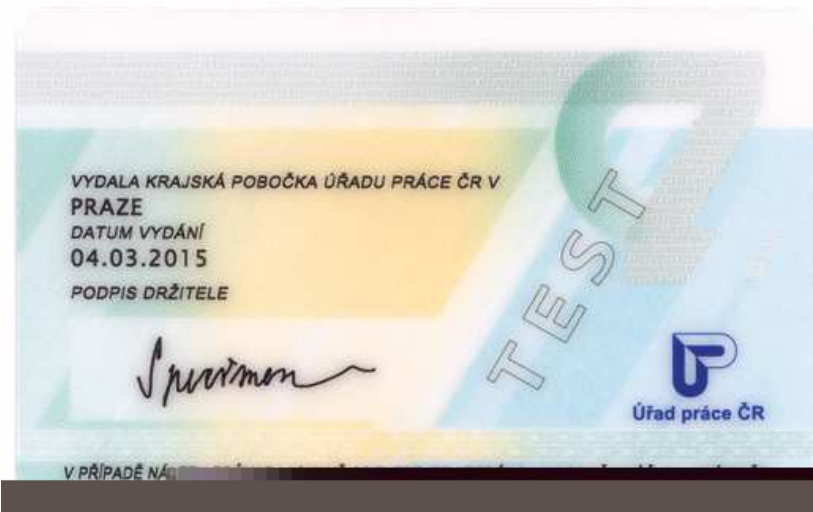
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Benefits for Persons with Disabilities

Card of a Person with Disability

TP , ZTP, ZTP/P

- Reserved seats in public transport.
- Reserved parking places.
- Free transport in public transportation, fare discounts in buses and trains etc.





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Assistance in Material Need

Living Allowance

Supplements one's income to the level of his/her Subsistence Minimum (CZK 3.410 for a single individual)

Supplement for Housing

Covers the housing costs if Housing Allowance is insufficient

Extraordinary Immediate Assistance

1. Risk to one's life or health
2. Persons afflicted by a serious extraordinary event
3. To cover a one-off expense (new ID, loss of money)
4. Purchase or repair of goods of long-term need (washer, refrigerator...)
5. Costs incurred in relation to education or interest activities of dependent children (max. CZK 34.100 a year)
6. Risk of social exclusion
